Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Autumn Quarter of 2004

October 13, 2004

Autumn Quarter began on September 22, 2004. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on October 11. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

An overall increase in enrollment of 111 students, compared to Autumn Quarter 2003, was recorded for this quarter. The Columbus campus increased by 264 to 50,995 (0.5%). The Lima campus decreased 57 to 1,281 (4.3%), Mansfield decreased 6 to 1,634 (-0.4%), Marion decreased 46 to 1,521 (-2.9%), Newark decreased 5 to 2,143 (-0.2%), and Wooster decreased 39 to 791 (-4.7%).

Increases in graduate professional enrollment (up 81 to 3,276; 2.5%) and graduate enrollment (up 232 to 10,571; 2.2%) offset the undergraduate enrollment decrease (down 202 to 44,518; -0.5%) to net an enrollment increase. The graduate professional enrollment of 3,276 surpassed the previous record of 3,195 from Autumn 2003. Three sources of undergraduate enrollment experienced increases, transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 67 to 1,408; 5.0%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 164 to 1,584; 11.5%) and continuing students (up 168 to 31,970; 0.5%). Sources which decreased were new first-quarter freshmen (down 482 to 8,032; -5.7%) and former students (down 119 to 1,524; -7.2%). At the extended campuses as a whole, two source categories recorded an increase: Transfer Students Above Rank 2 (up 22 to 499; 4.6%) and Continuing students (up 136 to 3,823; 3.7%). The remaining categories; new first-quarter freshmen (down 204 to 2,052; -9.0%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 17 to 219; -7.2%) and former students (down 43 to 416; -9.4%) saw decreases. Three sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus experienced increases from Autumn 2003: transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 84 to 1,189; 7.6%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 142 to 1,085; 15.1%) and continuing students (up 32 to 28,147; 0.1%). The remaining Undergraduate source categories on the Columbus campus experienced decreases: New first-quarter freshmen students (down 278 to 5,980; -4.4%), and former students (down 76 to 1,108; -6.4%). The enrollment of graduate students at Columbus campus for Autumn 2004 increased from Autumn 2003, up 279 to 10,210 (2.8%). The enrollment of graduate students at the extended campuses decreased by 47 to 361 (-11.5%). Overall, enrollment of new graduate students was up 14 to 2,427 (0.6%), as is the enrollment of returning graduate students (up 210 to 7,593; 2.8%) and former graduate students (up 8 to 551; 1.5%). In total, enrollment of graduate students was up 232 to 10,571 (2.2%) and enrollment of graduate professional students was up 81 to 3,276 (2.5%). [Table 2]

Five undergraduate curricular academic programs saw an increase in enrollment from Autumn 2003 in excess of ten percent. They are Arts and Sciences General (up 306 to 756, 68.0%), Education (up 76 to 737, 11.5%), Allied Medical Professions (up 142 to 1,084, 15.1%), Pharmacy (up 99 to 335, 41.9%) and Social Work (up 65 to 222, 41.4%). Four undergraduate curricular programs saw a decrease in excess of ten percent, Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 27 to 70, -27.8%), Journalism (down 25 to 188, -11.7%), Natural Resources (down 40 to 352, -10.2%) and USAS (down 499 to 4331, -10.3%). Graduate level programs that recorded changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent are the graduate program in Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (down 48 to 330; -12.7%), Allied Medical Professions (up 28 to 214; 15.1%), and Social Work (up 51 to 429; 13.5%). Credits generated by full-time undergraduates increased at Columbus (up 7,232 to 535,182; 1.4%) and decreased at the extended campuses as a whole (down 535 to 84,775; -0.6%). The net result was a total increase of 6,697 to 619,957 (1.1%) from Autumn Quarter 2003. Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 6.7% (down 2,005 to 27,718) and the extended campuses decreased as a whole 390 to 11,018; (-3.4%). The net result was an increase of 4,302 to 658,693 (0.7%) in credits generated by both full-time and part-time undergraduates for the entire university. As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level throughout the university increased, so did credits per student (up 0.16 to 14.80; 1.1%). At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 1,977 to 120,852; 1.7%). The Columbus campus reported an increase of 1.7% (up 2,000 to 117,445) and while the extended campuses as a whole reported a decrease of 23 to 3,407 (-0.7%). Graduate professional credits per student were up 1.0 percent while both headcount (up 81 to 3,276; 2.5%) and credits (up 2,282 to 65,494; 3.6%) also increased. Undergraduate FTE increased from 43,626 to 43,913. Graduate professional FTE increased from 4,214 to 4,366. Graduate FTE increased from 7,925 to 8,057. [Table 4]

For the total university, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Autumn 2003 were: Fayette (down 24.4%), Gallia (up 24.1%), Harrison (down 24.1%), Henry (up 22.7%) and Hocking (up 29.1%). At Columbus, one county recorded an enrollment change in excess of twenty percent: Hocking (up 23.1%) [Table 5 and Table 6]

For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from Autumn 2003 were: Oregon (up 21.4%), Oklahoma (up 26.7%), Delaware (up 25.9%), New Mexico (up 34.8%), Arkansas (down 24.1%), Mississippi (up 25.0%), Nevada (down 33.3%), North Dakota (up 55.6%), Wyoming (down 22.2%), and Virgin Islands (down 50.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changes in excess of twenty percent from last Autumn are: Oregon (up 21.4%), Oklahoma (up 26.7%), Delaware (up 22.2%), New Mexico (up 34.8%), Arkansas (down 27.6%), Mississippi (up 25.0%), Nevada (down 33.3%), North Dakota (up 55.6%), Wyoming (down 22.2%), and Virgin Islands (down 50.0%). Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at The Ohio State University, Hong Kong (down 22.4%), Brazil (up 41.7%) and Iran (up 28.6%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from Autumn 2003. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, Indonesia, Japan, Turkey and Canada recorded enrollment of 100 or more students in Autumn 2004. [Table 9]

On the Columbus campus, Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 11.4 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Business (8.7%) and Engineering (7.4%). Undergraduate international enrollment was 1,360 for the total university and 1,348 on the Columbus campus. On Columbus campus, forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (49.0%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (48.6%), Engineering (62.7%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (46.1%), Pharmacy (61.6%), and the graduate program in Veterinary Medicine (47.2%) were international students. For the entire university, a record high enrollment of 42 Professional international students was reached in Autumn 2004. [Table 10 and 12]

Autumn Quarter 2004 had a record high enrollment among Asian/Pacific Islander (2,693 at Columbus, 2,803 total) and Hispanic students (1,155 at Columbus, 1,248 total). [Tables 11, 12, and 13]

At the Undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 29 to 39,915; -0.1%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents also decreased (down 173 to 4,603; -3.6%). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 111 to 5,943; 1.9%); as well, enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased (up 121 to 4,628; 2.7%). An increase was recorded in Graduate Professional enrollment among Ohio residents (up 73 to 2,957; up 2.5%) and not-Ohio residents (up 8 to 319; 2.6%) for a total record high of 3,276. [Table 14]

Autumn 2004 had a record high 1,735 female Graduate Professional students. A record high of 29,359 total female students was reached for the entire university. [Table 16]
