Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Autumn Quarter of 2008

October 15, 2008

Autumn Quarter began on September 24, 2008. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on October 13. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- There was an overall increase in enrollment for Autumn Quarter 2008 compared to Autumn Quarter 2007 (up 1,221 to 61,568; 2.0%). Four campuses had increases in enrollment: Columbus (up 1,147 to 53,715; 2.2%), Lima (up 69 to 1,409; 5.1%), Marion (up 40 to 1,673; 2.4%), and Wooster (up 6 to 754; 0.8%). Two campuses had decreases in enrollment: Mansfield (down 8 to 1,545; -0.5%), and Newark (down 33 to 2,472; -1.3%). [Table 1]
- There were increases in undergraduate enrollment (up 1,061 to 47,751; 2.3%), graduate professional enrollment (up 22 to 3,284; 0.7%) and graduate enrollment (up 138 to 10,533; 1.3%) this quarter.

Two of five source categories of total undergraduate enrollment increased: transfer students above rank 2 (up 104 to 1,559; 7.1%), and continuing students (up 1,375 to 34,319; 4.2%). The three remaining source categories decreased: new first-quarter freshmen (down 116 to 8,960; -1.3%), transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (down 126 to 1,538; -7.6%), and former students (down 176 to 1,375; 11.3%).

At the Columbus campus, two undergraduate source categories increased: transfer students above rank 2 (up 85 to 1,157; 7.9%), and continuing students (up 1,314 to 30,691; 4.5%). The remaining three source categories decreased: new first quarter freshmen (down 69 to 6,041; -1.1%), transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (down 167 to 1,346; -11.0%), and former students (down 160 to 977; -14.1%).

At the extended campuses as a whole, three undergraduate source categories increased: transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (up 41 to 192; 27.2%), transfer students above rank 2 (up 19 to 402; 5.0%), and continuing students (up 61 to 3,628; 1.7%). The remaining two source categories decreased: new first quarter freshmen (down 47 to 2,919; -1.6%) and former students (down 16 to 398; -3.9%).

The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Autumn Quarter 2008 increased from Autumn Quarter 2007 (up 122 to 10,219; 1.2%) as well as the enrollment of graduate students at the extended campuses (up 16 to 314; 5.4%). Overall, enrollment increased for new graduate students (up 48 to 2,500; 2.0%), continuing graduate students (up 84 to 7,532; 1.1%), and former graduate students (up 6 to 501; 1.2%). [Table 2]

- At the Columbus campus, three undergraduate curricular programs saw an increase in enrollment from Autumn Quarter 2007 in excess of ten percent. They were: Arts and Sciences, Unknown (up 36 to 69; 109.1%), Earth Sciences (up 11 to 73; 17.7%), and Business (up 506 to 5,333; 10.5%). Two undergraduate programs saw a decrease in excess of ten percent: Dental Hygiene (down 38 to 139; -21.5%), and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (down 85 to 307; -21.7%). At the graduate level, four programs recorded enrollment increases in excess of ten percent: Nursing (up 45 to 351; 14.7%), Public Affairs (up 29 to 132; 28.2%), Law (up 1 to 3; 50.0%), and Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 100 to 803; 14.2%). Four graduate programs saw decreases in excess of ten percent: Earth Sciences (down 12 to 43; -21.8%), Pharmacy (down 15 to 82; -15.5%), Public Health (down 40 to 285; -12.3%), and Optometry (down 4 to 12; -25.0%) . [Table 3]
- For the total university, credits generated by undergraduates increased (up 19,215 to 719,639; 2.7%) from Autumn Quarter 2007. Columbus undergraduate credits increased (up 16,734 to 613,108; 2.8%) for both full-time (up 16,530 to 589,245; 2.9%) and part-time (up 204 to 23,863; 0.9%) students. At the extended campuses as a whole, there was a net increase of undergraduate credits (up 2,481 to 106,531; 2.4%), with full-time credits up (3,588 to 97,806; 3.8%) and part-time credits down (-1,107 to 8,725; -11.3%). As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level throughout the university increased, so did credits per student (up 0.07 to 15.07; 0.5%). At the graduate level for the total university, there was a net decrease in credits (down 10,493 to 111,905; -8.6%). Columbus graduate credits were down (-10,625 to 108,726; -8.9%), extended campus graduate credits were up (132 to 3,179; 4.3%). Graduate professional credits increased (up 437 to 64,077; 0.7%). Undergraduate FTE increased from 46,695 to 47,976. Graduate professional FTE increased from 4,243 to 4272. Graduate FTE decreased from 8,160 to 7,460. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Autumn Quarter 2007: Ashtabula (down 21.3%), Gallia (down 21.3%), and Morgan (up 52.6%). At Columbus, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative): Adams (up 23.8%), Ashtabula (down 22.1%), Gallia (down 23.6%), and Morgan (up 23.5%). [Tables 5 and 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Autumn Quarter 2007 were: Washington (up 23.8%), Nevada (up 52.0%), New Mexico (up 34.6%), Puerto Rico (down 23.7%), Rhode Island (up 21.1%), Vermont (up 66.7%), Montana (up 41.7%), Wyoming (up 60%), and North Dakota (down 37.5%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Autumn Quarter were: Washington (up 24.1%), Nevada (up 48.0%), New Mexico (up 36.0%), Puerto Rico (down 23.7%), Rhode Island (up 21.1%), Vermont (up 66.7%), Montana (up 41.7%), Wyoming (up 60%), and North Dakota (down 37.5%). Highlights

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- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at The Ohio State University, nine recorded changes in excess of twenty percent from Autumn Quarter 2007. They were: People's Republic of China (up 20.5%), Malaysia (down 21.2%), Saudi Arabia (up 21.9%), Italy (up 56.5%), Vietnam (up 68.8%), Pakistan (-23.3%), Colombia (29.4%), France (-22.7%), and Russia (30.8%). Also included in this group is Libya which had 36 students enrolled, up from 0 in Autumn 2007. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, and Canada recorded enrollment of 100 or more students in Autumn Quarter 2008. [Table 9]
- On the Columbus campus, Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 15.3 percent. Undergraduate curricular programs with international student enrollments in excess of five percent were Mathematical and Physical Sciences (6.0%), and Business (10.3%). Undergraduate international enrollment was 1,355 for the total university and 1,349 on the Columbus campus. On the Columbus campus, forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (46.1%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (44.3%), Engineering (57.6%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (45.4%), and Pharmacy (57.3%) were international students. [Tables 10, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment increased for both Ohio residents (up 536 to 42,692; 1.3%) and not-Ohio residents (up 525 to 5,059; 11.6%). At the Graduate level, enrollment increased for both Ohio residents (up 85 to 6,051; 1.4%) and not-Ohio residents (up 53 to 4,482; 1.2%). At the Graduate Professional level, enrollment increased for both Ohio residents (up 16 to 2,943; 0.5%) and not-Ohio residents (up 6 to 341; 1.8%). [Table 14]
- Autumn 2008 saw a record high total enrollment of 61,568. This included a record high undergraduate enrollment (47,751), male undergraduate enrollment (25,100), and female undergraduate enrollment (22,651). Female enrollment for all academic levels reached a record high (30,209). Graduate professional enrollment reached a record high (3,284). Record highs were also recorded for Asian or Pacific Islander students (2,968), and Hispanic students (1,519).
