Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Spring Quarter of 2006

April 17, 2006

Spring Quarter 2006 began on March 27, 2006. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on April 13th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 165 students compared to Spring Quarter 2005 was recorded this quarter for a total of 54,374. The Columbus campus experienced an increase in enrollment (up 285 to 48,177; 0.6%), as did the Newark campus (up 39 to 1,881; 2.1%). All other campuses experienced a decrease in enrollment from Spring Quarter 2005: Lima (down 97 to 1,023; -8.7%), Mansfield (down 32 to 1,338; -2.3%), Marion (down 4 to 1,357; -0.3%) and Wooster (down 26 to 598; -4.2%). [Table 1]
- An increase in Undergraduate enrollment was enough to offset the decrease in Graduate and Graduate Professional enrollment, netting an increase in total enrollment. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 263 to 40,953 (0.6%), while graduate enrollment decreased by 81 to 10,160 (-0.8%) and graduate professional enrollment decreased by 17 to 3,261 (-0.5%). Overall, three sources of undergraduate enrollment increased; new first-quarter freshmen (up 21 to 126; 20.0%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 47 to 451; 11.6%) and continuing students (up 248 to 38,856; 0.6%). The remaining two sources decreased; transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 11 to 280; -3.8%), and former students (down 42 to 1,240; -3.3%). At the extended campuses as a whole, three undergraduate source categories recorded decreases while two recorded increases. Enrollment of transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 9 to 46; -16.4%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 1 to 93; -1.1%) and continuing students (down 94 to 5,321; -1.7%) all decreased. Enrollment of new first quarter freshmen (up 19 to 100, 23.5%), and former students (up 18 to 316, 6.0%) both increased. Three of the sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus increased: new first-quarter freshmen (up 2 to 26, 8.3%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 48 to 358; 15.5%) and continuing students (up 342 to 33,535; 1.0%). The two remaining sources decreased; transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 2 to 234, -0.8%) and former students (down 60 to 924, -6.1%). The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Spring 2006 was less than Spring Quarter 2005, with a decrease of 28 to 9,839 (-0.3%). The enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was also less than Spring Quarter 2005 (down 53 to 321; -14.2%). [Table 2].

- Four undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus saw an increase in enrollment from Spring 2005 in excess of ten percent: Arts and Sciences, General (up 158 to 962; 19.7%), Dental Hygiene (up 17 to 158; 12.1%), Allied Medical Professions (up 181 to 1,266; 16.7%), and Pharmacy (up 69 to 422; 19.5%). Three undergraduate curricular academic programs at Columbus, Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 33 to 35; -48.5%), Journalism (down 33 to 144; -18.6%), and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (down 403 to 2,507; -13.8%), saw a decrease in excess of ten percent in enrollment from Spring 2005. Graduate level programs recording changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent were: Architecture (up 23 to 177; 14.9%), Human Ecology (down 11 to 89; -11.0%) and Allied Medical Professions (up 31 to 207; 17.6%). [Table 3]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduate students increased at Columbus (up 11,429 to 499,709; 2.3%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 1,065 to 69,632; 1.6%). The result was an overall increase of 12,494 to 569,341 (2.2%) of credits generated by full-time undergraduate students from Spring Quarter 2005. Credits for part-time students decreased in total; down 2,791 to 38,487 (-6.8%). Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 6.6% (down 1,999 to 28,377) while the extended campuses decreased 7.3% (down 792 to 10,110). The total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university increased 9,703 to 607,828 (1.6%). As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level for the university increased, credits per student increased slightly (up 0.14 to 14.84, 1.0%) compared to Spring 2005. At the graduate level, there was an overall decrease in credits (down 982 to 111,508; -0.9%). The Columbus campus decreased 1,021 to 108,396; (-0.9%) while the extended campuses as a whole increased 39 to 3,112; (1.3%). Graduate credits per student for the university as a whole were down 0.1% with 10.98 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were up by 2.9% (with 18.32 credits per student) as total credits increased by 1,354 credits to 59,756. Undergraduate FTE increased from 39,875 to 40,522. Graduate professional FTE increased from 3,893 to 3,984. Graduate FTE decreased from 7,499 to 7,434. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last Spring; Adams (up 53.8%), Harrison (up 50.0%), Morgan (down 31.3%), Noble (down 29.2%), Pike (up 20.9%) and Vinton (up 75.0%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Adams (up 46.2%), Harrison (up 37.5%), Morgan (down 30.8%), Noble (down 33.3%), Pike (up 23.8%) and Vinton (up 72.7%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were: Georgia (up 24.6%), Alabama (up 31.3%), Alaska (up 53.3%), Arkansas (down 20.8%), Wyoming (up 28.6%), the Virgin Islands (up 300.0%) and students with Military Addresses (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were: Georgia (up 24.8%), Alabama (up 35.5%), New Hampshire (up 26.1%), Alaska (up 57.1%), Arkansas (down 26.1%), Wyoming (up 28.6%), the Virgin Islands (up 300.0%) and students with Military Addresses (down 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Indonesia (down 29.0%), France (down 20.8%), Hong Kong (down 20.5%), Thailand (down 28.2%), Pakistan (down 20.8%) and Russia (down 33.3%) recorded a change in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Spring Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, Indonesia, Japan and Turkey recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent of the total enrolled were Business (8.2%), Engineering (6.2%) and Continuing Education (8.4%). International student enrollment was at 3,578 for the total university and 3,567 on the Columbus campus. Graduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of forty percent or more include Biological Sciences (47.6%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (48.4%), Engineering (60.8%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (45.5%), and Pharmacy (64.3%). The graduate program in Veterinary Medicine recorded an international enrollment of 43.3% of the total students enrolled in the program. Total University enrollment of 50 International Graduate Professional students was reported for Spring Quarter 2006. [Table 10]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 479 to 36,906; 1.3%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents decreased (down 216 to 4,047; -5.1%). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents increased slightly (up 1 to 6,021; 0.0%) while not-Ohio residents decreased (down 82 to 4,139; -1.9%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 7 to 2,951; -0.2%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents also decreased (down 10 to 310; -3.1%). [Table 14]
