Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Spring Quarter of 2007

April 16, 2007

Spring Quarter 2007 began on March 26, 2007. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on April 12th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 1,079 students compared to Spring Quarter 2006 was recorded this quarter for a total of 55,453. The Columbus campus experienced an increase in enrollment (up 807 to 48,984; 1.7%), as did the Lima campus (up 99 to 1,122; 9.7%), the Mansfield campus (up 33 to 1,371; 2.5%), the Marion campus (up 73 to 1,430; 5.4%), and the Newark campus (up 77 to 1,958; 4.1%). The Wooster campus experienced a decrease in enrollment from Spring Quarter 2006 (down 10 to 588; -1.7%). [Table 1]

- An increase in Undergraduate enrollment was enough to offset the decrease in Graduate and Graduate Professional enrollment, netting an increase in total enrollment. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1,234 to 42,187 (3.0%), while graduate enrollment decreased overall by 142 to 10,018 (-1.4%) and graduate professional enrollment decreased by 13 to 3,248 (-0.4%). Overall, two sources of undergraduate enrollment increased: transfer students Ranks 1 and 2 (up 20 to 300; 7.1%) and continuing students (up 1,378 to 40,234; 3.5%). The other three sources decreased: new first quarter freshmen students (down 18 to 108; -14.3%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 71 to 380; -15.7%), and former students (down 75 to 1,165; -6.0%). At the extended campuses as a whole, three undergraduate source categories recorded increases while two recorded decreases. Enrollment of transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 10 to 56; 21.7%), continuing students (up 273 to 5,594; 5.1%), and former students (up 8 to 324; 2.5%) all increased. Enrollment of new first quarter freshmen (down 17 to 83, -17.0%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 33 to 60, -35.5%) both decreased. Three of the sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus decreased: new first-quarter freshmen (down 1 to 25, -3.8%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 38 to 320; -10.6%) and former students (down 83 to 841; -9.0%). The two remaining sources increased: transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 10 to 244, 4.3%) and continuing students (up 1,105 to 34,640, 3.3%). The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Spring 2007 was less than Spring Quarter 2006, with a decrease of 173 to 9,666 (-1.8%). The enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was greater than Spring Quarter 2006 (up 31 to 352; 9.7%). [Table 2]

- Five undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus saw an increase in enrollment from Spring 2006 in excess of ten percent: Arts and Sciences, General (up 270 to 1,231; 28.1%), Arts and Sciences, Unknown (up 13 to 48; 37.1%), Earth Sciences (up 11 to 60; 22.4%), Pharmacy (up 64 to 486; 15.2%), and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (up 133 to 199; 201.5%). Only one undergraduate curricular academic programs at Columbus, the Exploration Program (down 431 to 2,010; -17.7%), saw a decrease in excess of ten percent in enrollment from Spring 2006. Graduate level programs recording changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent were: Education and Human Ecology (down 219 to 1,677; -11.6%), Allied Medical Professions (up 31 to 238; 15.0%), Nursing (up 27 to 278; 10.8%), Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (down 111 to 686; -13.9%), Public Affairs (down 13 to 87; -13.0%), Public Health (up 45 to 260; 20.9%), Social Work (up 47 to 454; 11.5%), Medicine (up 15 to 151; 11.0%), and Veterinary Medicine (down 13 to 107; -10.8%). [Table 3]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduate students increased at Columbus (up 14,163 to 513,872; 2.8%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 3,978 to 73,610; 5.7%). The result was an overall increase of 18,141 to 587,482 (3.2%) of credits generated by full-time undergraduate students from Spring Quarter 2006. Credits for part-time students decreased in total; down 307 to 38,180 (-0.8%). Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 0.7% (down 192 to 28,185) while the extended campuses decreased 1.1% (down 115 to 9,995). The total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university increased 17,834 to 625,662 (2.9%). As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level for the university increased, credits per student decreased slightly (down 0.01 to 14.83; -0.1%) compared to Spring 2006. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 1,547 to 113,055; 1.4%). The Columbus campus increased 1,767 to 110,163; (1.6%) while the extended campuses as a whole decreased 220 to 2,892; (-7.1%). Graduate credits per student for the university as a whole were up 2.8% with 11.29 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were up by 0.3% (with 18.38 credits per student) as total credits decreased by 52 credits to 59,704 (-0.1%). Undergraduate FTE increased from 40,522 to 41,711. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 3,984 to 3,980. Graduate FTE increased from 7,434 to 7,537. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following eight counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last Spring; Adams (up 25.0%), Carroll (down 21.6%), Darke (up 26.3%), Jackson (up 59.0%), Monroe (down 25.7%), Morgan (down 22.7%), Preble (up 22.0%), and Washington (up 23.4%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Carroll (down 33.3%), Darke (up 26.4%), Jackson (up 60.5%), Monroe (down 32.3%), Noble (up 21.4%), and Washington (up 24.7%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were the District of Columbia (up 31.4%), Oklahoma (up 24.2%), Nevada (up 31.3%), South Dakota (up 80.0%), Virgin Islands (down 25.0%), Guam (down 100.0%) and Northern Mariana Islands (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were the District of Columbia (up 31.4%), Oklahoma (up 25.0%), Alaska (up 22.7%), Nevada (up 31.3%), South Dakota (up 80.0%), Virgin Islands (down 25.0%), Guam (down 100.0%), and Northern Mariana Islands (down 100.0%). Highlights

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- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Indonesia (down 32.8%), Malaysia (down 32.4%), France (down 22.8%), Saudi Arabia (up 208.3%), Jamaica (up 150.0%), Romania (down 34.5%), and Italy (up 41.7%) recorded a change in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Spring Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, and Japan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent of the total enrolled were Mathematical and Physical Sciences (5.4%), Business (7.2%), and Continuing Education (13.5%). International student enrollment was at 3,411 for the total university and 3,402 on the Columbus campus. Graduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of forty percent or more include Biological Sciences (48.4%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (47.4%), Engineering (56.9%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (46.7%), and Pharmacy (54.9%). The graduate program in Veterinary Medicine recorded an international enrollment of 40.2% of the total students enrolled in the program. Total University enrollment of 46 International Graduate Professional students was reported for Spring Quarter 2007. [Table 10 and Table 11]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 1,176 to 38,082; 3.2%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased (up 58 to 4,105; 1.4%). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 98 to 5,923; -1.6%) and not-Ohio residents decreased (down 44 to 4,095; -1.1%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 49 to 2,902; -1.7%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased (up 36 to 346; 11.6%). [Table 14]
- Spring 2007 had a record high enrollment for the total university of 55,453 students, a record high enrollment of 226 for American Indian or Alaskan Native students, a record high enrollment of 2,730 for Asian or Pacific Islander students and a record high enrollment of 1,251 for Hispanic students.
