Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Spring Quarter of 2008

April 14, 2008

Spring Quarter 2008 began on March 24, 2008. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on April 10th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 920 students compared to Spring Quarter 2007 was recorded this quarter for a total of 56,373. The Columbus campus experienced an increase in enrollment (up 704 to 49,688; 1.4%), as did the Lima campus (up 69 to 1,191; 6.1%), and the Newark campus (up 198 to 2,156; 10.1%). The Mansfield campus (down 3 to 1,368; -0.2%), the Marion campus (down 39 to 1,391; -2.7%), and the Wooster campus (down 9 to 579; -1.5%) experienced a decrease in enrollment from Spring Quarter 2007. [Table 1]

- An increase in Undergraduate and Graduate enrollment was enough to offset the decrease in Graduate Professional enrollment, netting an increase in total enrollment. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 838 to 43,025 (2.0%) and graduate enrollment increased overall by 116 to 10,134 (1.2%), while graduate professional enrollment decreased by 34 to 3,214 (-1.0%). Overall, two sources of undergraduate enrollment increased: transfer students above Rank 2 (up 62 to 442; 16.3%) and continuing students (up 923 to 41,157; 2.3%). The other three sources decreased: new first quarter freshmen students (down 7 to 101; -6.5%), transfer students Ranks 1 and 2 (down 49 to 251; -16.3%), and former students (down 91 to 1,074; -7.8%). At the extended campuses as a whole, two undergraduate source categories recorded increases while three recorded decreases. Enrollment of transfer students above Rank 2 (up 33 to 93; 55.0%) and continuing students (up 284 to 5,878; 5.1%) experienced an increase while enrollment of new first quarter freshmen (down 4 to 79, -4.8%), transfer students in Rank 1 or 2 (down 5 to 51, -8.9%), and former students (down 54 to 270; -16.7%) all decreased. Like the extended campuses, three sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus decreased: new first-quarter freshmen (down 3 to 22, -12.0%), transfer students in Rank 1 or 2 (down 44 to 200; -18.0%) and former students (down 37 to 804; -4.4%). The two remaining sources increased: transfer students above Rank 2 (up 29 to 349, 9.1%) and continuing students (up 639 to 35,279, 1.8%). The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Spring 2008 was greater than Spring Quarter 2007, with an increase of 154 to 9,820 (1.6%). The enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was fewer than Spring Quarter 2007 (down 38 to 314; -10.8%). [Table 2]

- Zero undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus saw an increase or decrease in enrollment from Spring 2007 in excess of ten percent. However, eight graduate level programs recorded changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent: Arts and Sciences, General (down 1 to 0; -100%), Biological Sciences (down 57 to 356; -13.8%), Engineering (up 106 to 1,148; 10.2%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (up 60 to 390; 18.2%), Nursing (up 37 to 315; 13.3%), and Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 79 to 765; 11.5%), Optometry (up 2 to 15; 15.4%), and Veterinary Medicine (down 11 to 96; -10.3%). [Table 3]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduate students increased at Columbus (up 13,639 to 527,511; 2.7%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 4,500 to 78,110; 6.1%). The result was an overall increase of 18,139 to 605,621 (3.1%) of credits generated by full-time undergraduate students from Spring Quarter 2007. Credits for part-time students decreased in total; down 1,354 to 36,826 (-3.5%). Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 3.5% (down 997 to 27,188) while the extended campuses decreased 3.6% (down 357 to 9,638). The total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university increased 16,785 to 642,447 (2.7%). As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level for the university increased, credits per student increased slightly (up 0.10 to 14.93; 0.7%) compared to Spring 2007. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 772 to 113,827; 0.7%). The Columbus campus increased 1,150 to 111,313; (1.0%) while the extended campuses as a whole decreased 378 to 2,514; (-13.1%). Graduate credits per student for the university as a whole were down 0.5% with 11.23 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were up by 1.2% (with 18.59 credits per student) as total credits increased by 56 credits to 59,760 (0.1%). Undergraduate FTE increased from 41,711 to 42,830. Graduate professional FTE increased from 3,980 to 3,984. Graduate FTE increased from 7,537 to 7,588. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following five counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last Spring: Brown (up 22.5%), Clinton (up 29.4%), Fayette (up 21.0%), Meigs (down 25.8%) and Noble (up 22.2%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Brown (up 25.7%) and Clinton (up 20.9%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were Florida (up 27.1%), Minnesota (up 21.0%), Washington (up 31.3%), New Hampshire (up 29.4%), the District of Columbia (down 23.9%), Louisiana (down 25.6%), Puerto Rico (down 23.1%), Maine (up 27.3%), Nevada (up 28.6%), Hawaii (up 29.4%), Rhode Island (down 23.5%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 31.3%), Northern Mariana Islands (up 100.0%), Virgin Islands (down 66.7%), Military Addresses (down 100.0%), and Palau Island (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Spring were Florida (up 27.5%), Minnesota (up 21.0%), Washington (up 29.7%), New Hampshire (up 29.4%), Kansas (up 23.5%), the District of Columbia (down 23.9%), Louisiana (down 25.6%), Puerto Rico (down 23.1%), Maine (up 22.7%), Nevada (up 28.6%), Hawaii (up 29.4%), Rhode Island (down 23.5%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 31.3%), Northern Mariana Islands (up 100.0%), Virgin Islands (down 66.7%), Military Addresses (down 100.0%), and Palau Island (down 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Japan (down 22.9%), Indonesia (down 25.0%), France (up 50.0%), Pakistan (up 42.9%), Saudi Arabia (down 27.0%), and Vietnam (up 50.0%) recorded a change in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Spring Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, and Taiwan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent of the total enrolled were Business (8.6%) and Continuing Education (9.8%). International student enrollment was at 3,434 for the total university and 3,426 on the Columbus campus. Graduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of forty percent or more include Biological Sciences (46.3%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (46.4%), Engineering (57.1%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (44.6%), and Pharmacy (55.1%). Total University enrollment of 37 International Graduate Professional students was reported for Spring Quarter 2008. [Table 10 and Table 11]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents (up 631 to 38,713; 1.7%) and Not Ohio residents (up 207 to 4,312; 5.0%) increased. Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 58 to 5,981; 1.0%) and Not Ohio residents increased (up 58 to 4,153; 1.4%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 11 to 2,913; 0.4%) while enrollment of Not Ohio residents decreased (down 45 to 301; -13.0%). [Table 14]
- Spring 2008 had a record high enrollment for the total university of 56,373 students and a record high enrollment of 43,025 undergraduates. Contributing to the record high for undergraduate enrollment are the record high enrollments of male undergrads, 22,368, and female undergrads, 20,657. There was also an overall record high enrollment of females for Spring 2008 of 28,123 and a record high minority enrollment of 1,351 for hispanic students.
