Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Spring Quarter of 2009

April 20, 2009

Spring Quarter began on March 30, 2009. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on April 13. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- There was an overall increase in enrollment for Spring Quarter 2009 compared to Spring Quarter 2008 (up 1,093 to 57,466; 1.9%). Four campuses had increases in enrollment: Columbus (up 939 to 50,627; 1.9%), Lima (up 105 to 1,296; 8.8%), Mansfield (up 3 to 1,371; 0.2%), and Marion (up 134 to 1,525; 9.6%). Two campuses had decreases in enrollment: Newark (down 86 to 2,070; -4.0%), and Wooster (down 2 to 577; -0.3%). [Table 1]
- Undergraduate enrollment increased this quarter (up 993 to 44,018; 2.3%), as well as graduate professional enrollment (up 34 to 3,248; 1.1%) and graduate enrollment (up 66 to 10,200; 0.7%).

Three of five source categories of total undergraduate enrollment increased: new first-quarter freshman (up 46 to 147; 45.5%), continuing students (up 845 to 42,002; 2.1%), and former students (up 130 to 1,204; 12.1%). The two remaining source categories decreased: transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (down 14 to 237; -5.6%), and transfer students above rank 2 (down 14 to 428; -3.2%).

At the Columbus campus, three undergraduate source categories increased: new first-quarter freshman (up 12 to 34; 54.5%), continuing students (up 795 to 36,074; 2.3%), and former students (up 114 to 918; 14.2%). The remaining two source categories decreased: transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (down 12 to 188; -6.0%), and transfer students above rank 2 (down 10 to 339; -2.9%).

At the extended campuses as a whole, three undergraduate source categories increased: new first-quarter freshman (up 34 to 113; 43.0%), continuing students (up 50 to 5,928; 0.9%), and former students (up 16 to 286; 5.9%). The remaining two source categories decreased: transfer students in ranks 1 and 2 (down 2 to 49; -3.9%) and transfer students above rank 2 (down 4 to 89; -4.3%).

The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Spring Quarter 2009 increased from Spring Quarter 2008 (up 6 to 9,826; 0.1%) as did the enrollment of graduate students at the extended campuses (up 60 to 374; 19.1%). Total university enrollment increased for former graduate students (up 159 to 900; 21.5%), but decreased for new graduate students (down 44 to 231; -16.0%), and continuing graduate students (down 49 to 9,069; -0.5%). [Table 2]

- At the Columbus campus, three undergraduate curricular programs saw an increase in enrollment from Spring Quarter 2008 in excess of ten percent. They were: Arts and Sciences (up 44 to 94; 88.0%), Earth Sciences (up 11 to 73; 17.7%), and Social Work (up 27 to 295; 10.1%). Three undergraduate programs saw a decrease in excess of ten percent: Dental Hygiene (down 27 to 127; -17.5%), Pharmacy (down 58 to 408; -12.4%), and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (down 42 to 162; -20.6%). Additionally, Continuing Education saw a decrease in excess of ten percent (down 121 to 764; -13.7%). At the graduate level, three programs recorded enrollment increases in excess of ten percent: Nursing (up 46 to 361; 14.6%), Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 103 to 868; 13.5%), and Public Affairs (up 21 to 112; 23.1%). Five graduate programs saw decreases in excess of ten percent: Earth Sciences (down 9 to 40; -18.4%), Education and Human Ecology (down 178 to 1,400; -11.3%), Pharmacy (down 12 to 77; -13.5%), Public Health (down 38 to 248; -13.3%), and Optometry (down 3 to 12; -20.0%) . [Table 3]
- For the total university, credits generated by undergraduates increased (up 20,095 to 662,542; 3.1%) from Spring Quarter 2008. There was a net increase for Columbus undergraduate credits (up 17,821 to 572,520; 3.2%) with full-time credits up (18,400 to 545,911; 3.5%) and part-time credit down (-579 to 26,609; -2.1%). At the extended campuses as a whole, there was a net increase of undergraduate credits (up 2,274 to 90,022; 2.6%), with full-time credits up (2,848 to 80,958; 3.6%) and part-time credits down (-574 to 9,064; -6.0%). As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level throughout the university increased, so did credits per student (up 0.12 to 15.05; 0.8%). At the graduate level for the total university, there was a net decrease in credits (down 13,528 to 100,299; -11.9%). Columbus graduate credits were down (-13,942 to 97,371; -12.5%), extended campus graduate credits were up (414 to 2,928; 16.5%). Graduate professional credits increased (up 789 to 60,549; 1.3%). Undergraduate FTE increased from 42,830 to 44,169. Graduate professional FTE increased from 3984 to 4037. Graduate FTE decreased from 7,588 to 6,687. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Spring Quarter 2008: Brown (up 28.6%), Holmes (up 24.5%), Morgan (up 36.8%), Noble (down -31.8%), and Vinton (down -25.0%). At Columbus, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Spring Quarter 2008: Adams (up 26.3%), Brown (up 22.7%), Gallia (down -21.5%), Harrison (up 25.0%), Holmes (up 32.3%), Monroe (up 23.5%), Noble (down -30.0%), and Preble (up 22.0%). - For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from Spring Quarter 2008 were Mississippi (up 21.1%), Rhode Island (up 69.2%), Vermont (up 72.7%), Wyoming (up 30.0%), North Dakota (down -25.0%), and Virgin Islands (up 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Spring Quarter 2008 were Mississippi (up 21.1%), Rhode Island (up 69.2%), Vermont (up 63.6%), Wyoming (up 30.0%), North Dakota (down -25.0%), and Virgin Islands (up 100.0%). Highlights

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- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at The Ohio State University, seven recorded changes in excess of twenty percent from Spring Quarter 2008. They were: People's Republic of China (up 25.6%), France (down -39.4%), Hong Kong (down -23.7%), United Arab Emirates (up 86.7%), Pakistan (down -23.3%), Vietnam (up 27.8%), and Libya (up 450.0%). People's Republic of China, India, Republic of Korea, Taiwan, and Canada recorded enrollment of 100 or more students in Spring Quarter 2009. [Table 9]
- On the Columbus campus, Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 10.6 percent. Two undergraduate curricular programs had an international student enrollment in excess of five percent: Mathematical and Physical Sciences (6.3%) and Business (11.5%). Undergraduate international enrollment was 1,294 for the total university and 1,289 on the Columbus campus. On the Columbus campus, forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (47.3%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (43.8%), Engineering (56.5%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (46.7%), and Pharmacy (55.8%) were international students. [Tables 10, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment increased for both Ohio residents (up 658 to 39,371; 1.7%) and not-Ohio residents (up 335 to 4,647; 7.8%). At the Graduate level, enrollment increased for both Ohio residents (up 36 to 6,017; 0.6%) and not-Ohio residents (up 30 to 4,183; 0.7%). At the Graduate Professional level, enrollment increased for Ohio residents (up 6 to 2,919; 0.2%) and not-Ohio residents (up 28 to 329; 9.3%). [Table 14]
- Spring 2009 saw a record high total enrollment of 57,466. This included a record high undergraduate enrollment (44,016), male undergraduate enrollment (23,022), and female undergraduate enrollment (20,996). Female enrollment for all academic levels reached a record high (28,497). Record highs were also recorded for Asian or Pacific Islander students (2,795) and Hispanic students (1,413).
