Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2002

August 14, 2002

Summer Quarter 2002 began on June 24, 2002. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 12. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained therein.

An overall increase in enrollment of 451 students compared to Summer Quarter 2001 was recorded for this quarter. Increases were experienced at all but one campus with Columbus increasing 344 to 19,669, (1.8%), Lima up 23 to 581, (4.1%), Mansfield up 1 to 472, (0.2%), Marion up 85 to 443, (23.7%) and Newark up 19 to 721, (2.7%). Only Wooster had a decrease (down 21 to 218, -8.8%). [Table 1]

Increases in total university undergraduate enrollment (up 174 to 13,127, 1.3%) and graduate enrollment (up 316 to 7,978, 4.1%) resulted in the overall enrollment increase. Graduate professional student enrollment was down 39 (to 999, -3.8%). Increases in undergraduate enrollment were recorded for transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 15 to 152, 10.9%) and continuing students (up 549 to 11,478, 5.0%). Decreases in undergraduate enrollment were recorded for new first quarter freshmen (down 10 to 153, -6.1%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 116 to 610, -16.0%), and former students (down 264 to 734, -26.5%). An overall increase in extended campus undergraduate enrollment of 225 students (to 1,908, 13.4%) was recorded. This was due to increases in continuing students (up 233 to 1,505; 18.3%) and former students up 8 (to 170, 4.9%). Extended campuses as a whole experienced decreases in new first quarter freshmen (down 3 to 63, -4.5%) and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 13 to 142, -8.4%). Columbus campus undergraduate enrollment was down 51 to 11,219 (-0.5%). This decrease was due to decreases in new first quarter freshmen (down 7 to 90, -7.2%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 103 to 468, -18.0%), and former students (down 272 to 564, -32.5%). Increased Columbus campus undergraduate enrollments were recorded in transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 15 to 124, 13.8%) and continuing students (up 316 to 9,973, 3.3%). Graduate student enrollment at all extended campuses was down 118 (to 527, -18.3%). Overall graduate student enrollment increased 135 for continuing students (to 5,878, 2.4%), 44 for former students (to 922, 5.0%), and 137 (to 1178, 13.2%) for new students. [Table 2]

Beginning Summer 2001, Undergraduate Student Academic Services replaced University College as part of an effort to facilitate the University's move toward direct enrollment and may have had an effect on changes in enrollment. In addition, policy changes within the College of Arts and Sciences in the past year may also have contributed to enrollment fluctuations in their curricular programs. Ten undergraduate curricular programs at the Columbus campus saw increases in excess of ten percent. They are Arts and Sciences, Unknown (up 33 to 75, 78.6%), Biological Sciences (up 106 to 566, 23.0%), Math and Physical Sciences (up 219 to 422, 107.9%), Social and Behavioral Sciences (up 347 to 2,225) 18.5%), Business (up 131 to 1,260, 11.6%), Dental Hygiene (up 8 to 53, 17.8%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (up 33 to 302, 12.3%), Natural Resources (up 22 to 112, 24.4%) Human Ecology (up 246 to 1,057, 30.3%), and Allied Medical Professions (up 42 to 256, 19.6%). Seven undergraduate curricular program saw a decrease in excess of ten percent, Arts and Sciences General (down 308 to 200, -60.6%), The Arts (down 47 to 378, -11.1%), Journalism (down 55 to 78, -41.4%), Continuing Education (down 98 to 688, -12.5%), Education (down 189 to 209, -47.5%), Pharmacy (down 18 to 106, -14.5%), and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (down 668 to 80, -44.0%). Three graduate level programs recorded increases in excess of ten percent compared to Summer 2001: Business (up 144 to 387, 59.3%), Allied Medical Professions (up 62 to 128, 93.9%), and Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 228 to 701, 48.2%). The graduate programs in Medicine experienced a 17.7% increase (up 25 to 166), Optometry experienced a 25.0% increase (up 2 to 10) and Veterinary Medicine had a 11.3% increase compared to Summer 2001 (up 11 to 108). One graduate level program experienced a decrease in excess of ten percent: Human Ecology (down 12 to 88, -12.0%). One graduate professional level program recorded a change (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent: Pharmacy (down 31 to 4, -88.6%). [Table 3]

Credits generated by full-time undergraduates increased both at Columbus (up 1,101 to 69,117 1.6%) and the extended campuses as a whole (up 1,632 to 7,781, 26.5%) for a combined increase of 2,733 to 76,898 (3.7%) compared to Summer Quarter 2001. Credits for part-time undergraduate students increased at Columbus (up 1,301 to 44,013, 3.0%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 902 to 9,137, 11.0%) for a combined increase of 2,203 to 53,150 (4.3%) compared to Summer Quarter 2001. Full-time and part-time undergraduate credit combined for a total increase of 4,936 to 130,048 (3.9%) for the entire university. Credits attempted per student throughout the university increased (up 0.25 to 9.91, 2.6%) compared to Summer 2001. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 2,952 to 76,115, 4.0%). This increase is due to an increase in credits at the Columbus campus (up 4,142 to 72,457, 6.1%) while the extended campuses as a whole decreased (down 1,190 to 3,658, -24.5%). Graduate credits per student are down slightly by 0.1%. Graduate professional credits per student are up by 0.9% (up 0.12 to 13.55) however both headcount (down 39 to 999 (-3.8%) and credits (down 404 to 13,541, -2.9%) decreased. Undergraduate FTE increased from 8,341 to 8,670. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 930 to 903. Graduate FTE increased from 4,878 to 5,074. [Table 4]

For the total university, five counties experienced an enrollment change in excess of forty percent (positive or negative): Fayette (up 41.2%), Fulton (up 66.7%), Hancock (up 60.0%), Miami (up 49.2%), and Vinton (up 250.0%). At Columbus, the counties that recorded enrollment changes in excess of forty percent (positive or negative) from Summer 2001 are: Carroll (down 50.0%), Fulton (up 55.6%), Hancock (up 57.1%), Miami (up 47.4%), Morgan (down 57.1%), Paulding (down 57.1%), and Vinton (up 200.0%). For the total university, the following states and territories recorded enrollment changes in excess of forty percent from last Summer: New Hampshire (up 157.1%), Nevada (down 60.0%), Vermont (up 100.0%), and Virgin Islands (down 50.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of forty percent from last Summer are: Iowa (down 42.4%), New Hampshire (up 157.1%), Nevada (down 60.0%), Vermont (up 100.0%), and Virgin Islands (down 50.0%). Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, India (up 21.3%), Indonesia (down 25.0%), Russia (down 23.5%), Mexico (up 23.5%), United Arab Emirates (up 42.9%), Pakistan (down 28.6%), Kuwait (up 55.6%), and Nigeria (up 40.0%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from Summer Quarter 2001 . People's Republic of China, India, Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Indonesia and Japan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]

Columbus Campus Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent are Mathematical and Physical Sciences (7.8%), Business (14.6%), Engineering (12.3%), and Architecture (6.3%). Continuing Education has an international enrollment of 10.3 percent and Undergraduate Student Academic Services has an international enrollment of 7.9 percent. Undergraduate international enrollment for the total university is 712, with 709 at the Columbus campus and 3 at the extended campuses. Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (46.1%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (49.2%), Journalism (48.3%), Engineering (72.2%), Architecture (42.5%), Food, Agricultural & Environmental Sciences (43.7%), Pharmacy (58.4%) and the graduate program in Veterinary Medicine (42.6%) are international students. [Table 10]

Summer 2002 recorded an all-time high enrollment for Summer Quarter among African American students (1,607 total, 1,532 Columbus campus), American Indian/Alaskan Native students (87 total, 76 Columbus campus), and Hispanic students (374 total, 352 Columbus campus). There was a record high enrollment of 11,993 female students and 2,017 international graduate. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]

At the undergraduate level, enrollment increases were recorded for Ohio residents (up 440 to 11,738, 3.9%), and not-Ohio residents (down 266 to 1,389, -16.1%). At the graduate level an enrollment increase was recorded for Ohio residents (up 149 to 4,762 , 3.2%) and not-Ohio residents (up 167 to 3,216, 5.5%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents decreased 49 to 945 (down 4.9%) and not-Ohio residents increased 10 to 54 (up 22.7%). [Table 14]
