Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2004

August 12, 2004

Summer Quarter 2004 began June 21, 2004. A census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 9th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 375 compared to Summer Quarter of 2003 was recorded for this quarter. Increases were experienced at Lima (up 8 to 475; 1.7%), Mansfield (up 14 to 446; 3.2%), Marion (up 36 to 492; 7.9%) and Newark (up 22 to 680; 3.3%) while Columbus (down 426 to 19,333; -2.2%) and Wooster (down 29 to 174; -14.3%) had decreases in enrollment compared to Summer Quarter 2003. [Table 1].
- Undergraduate enrollment (down 399 to 12,658; -3.1%) and graduate enrollment (down 11 to 7,852; -0.1%) decreased while graduate professional enrollment (up 35 to 1,090; 3.3%) increased. New first quarter freshman (down 55 to 149 -27.0%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 31 to 588 - 5.0%) and Continuing students (down 381 to 11,056; -3.3%) experienced decreases. Transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 21 to 136; 18.3%) and Former students (up 47 to 729 (6.9%) increased. New to OSU graduate students (up 29 to 561; 5.5%) and New from OSU graduate students (up 64 to 664; 10.7%) are up while Continuing students (down 15 to 5,882; -0.3%) and former graduate students (down 89 to 745; -10.7%) are down. - Nine undergraduate curricular academic programs recorded enrollment shifts of more than fifteen percent compared to last year. These are Arts and Sciences, General (up 147 to 302; 94.8%), Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 18 to 28; -39.1%), Music (down 10 to 50; -16.7%), Math and Physical Sciences (down 66 to 304; -17.8%), Dental Hygiene (down 12 to 38; -24.0%), Architecture (down 16 to 63; -20.3%), Nursing (up 37 to 116; 46.8%), Social Work (up 25 to 43; 138.9%) and USAS (down 198 to 596; -24.9%). Graduate programs with changes in excess of fifteen percent are: Journalism (down 11 to 21; -34.4%), Architecture (down 15 to 56; -21.1%) and the graduate program in Medicine (up 43 to 212; 25.4%). Graduate professional programs recording a change in excess of fifteen percent were Law, (up 35 to 186; 23.2%) and Pharmacy (down 6 to 17; -26.1%) [Table 3].
- Credits generated by full time undergraduates at Columbus increased 1.3% (to 73,779) and the extended campuses increased 14.0% to 9,124. The total increase in full-time undergraduate credit hours was 2,105, up 2.6% from the Summer of 2003. Overall, part-time credit hours decreased (down 3,435 to 48,179; -6.7%). Both the Columbus campus (-7.5%) and the extended campuses (-2.3%) experienced a decrease in total part-time credit hours. Overall, the total number of credit hours decreased 1,330 to 131,082 (down 1.0%) while the credits per student increased to 10.36 (up 0.21; 2.1%). Although there was a decrease in the number of graduate students, the number of total graduate credit hours increased 1,424 to 77,894 (1.9%). Full-time graduate credit hours increased 2.3% to 55,648 on the Columbus campus and 11.6% to 1,104 on the extended campuses as a whole yielding an overall full-time graduate credit hour increase of 2.5% to 56,752. Graduate credits per student for the entire university were up 0.19 to 9.92 (2.0%). Graduate professional credit hours were up 1,825 to 16,325, (12.6%) and credits per student were up 9.0% to 14.98. Undergraduate FTE decreased from 8,827 from Summer 2003 to 8,739. Graduate professional FTE increased from 967 to 1,088. Graduate FTE increased to 5,193 from 5,098. [Table 4]

- For the total university, twenty four counties recorded enrollment changes (positive or negative) in excess of twenty percent from last Summer; Adams (down 40.0%), Athens (down 30.2%), Brown (down 23.1%), Carroll (up 70.0%), Champaign (down 28.6%), Clermont (up 33.3%), Darke (down 20.8%) Erie (down 24.5%), Green (down 23.4%), Guernsey (down 27.9%), Henry (up 52.4%), Highland (down 34.5%), Logan (down 23.1%), Miami (up 43.2%), Monroe (down 47.1%), Morgan (down 50.0%), Noble (down 37.5%), Ottawa (up 57.7%), Perry (up 38.6%), Pike (up 75.0%), Preble (down 31.6%), Union (up 28.7%), Van Wert (up 38.6%) and Washington (down 27.1%). For the Columbus campus, twenty eight counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent: Adams (down 40.0%), Athens (down 35.7%), Brown (down 23.1%), Carroll (up 88.9%) Champaign (down 25.0%), Clermont (up 36.8%) Erie (down 24.1%), Gallia (down 22.2%), Green (down 22.9%), Guernsey (down 23.7%), Hardin (down 28.6%), Henry (up 45.0%), Highland (down 35.7%), Meigs (up 28.6%), Miami (up 38.6%), Monroe (down 47.1%), Morgan (down 50.0%), Morrow (up 27.8%), Noble (down 37.5%), Ottawa (up 52.0%), Perry (up 26.9%), Pike (up 62.5%), Preble (down 27.8%), Putnum (down 28.6%), Ross (down 25.0%), Union (up 24.2%), Van Wert (up 36.0%) and Washington (down 24.2%). - For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Maryland (up 21.3%), Utah (up 29.4%), Tennessee (up 28.3%), Washington (up 23.3%), Louisiana (up 34.8%), Oklahoma (up 66.7%), Kansas (down 24.0%), Hawaii (up 63.6%), Idaho (down 27.3%), Delaware (up 87.5%), District of Columbia (up 30.0%), Arkansas (down 27.3%), New Hampshire (up 33.3%), Wyoming (up 50.0%), Montana (up 25.0%), Nevada (down 44.4%), and North Dakota (up 66.7%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Texas (up 20.2%), Maryland (up 22.7%), Utah (up 29.9%), Tennessee (up 28.9%), Washington (up 23.3%), Louisiana (up 34.8%), Iowa (up 23.8%), Oklahoma (up 66.7%), Kansas (down 20.8%), Hawaii (up 54.5%), Idaho (down 27.3%), Delaware (up 87.5%), District of Columbia (up 30.0%), Vermont (up 28.6%), Arkansas (down 27.3%), New Hampshire (up 33.3%), Wyoming (up 50.0%), Montana (up 25.0%), Nevada (down 44.4%), North Dakota (up 66.7%) and South Dakota (down 33.3%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Turkey (up 20.8%), Malaysia (down 30.0%), Russia (up 22.2%), Brazil (up 42.9%), Thailand (down 25.9%), Pakistan (down 36.8) and Spain (down 29.4%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Summer Quarter. People's Republic of China, India, Republic of Korea, Taiwan and Indonesia recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 8.3 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Arts and Sciences General (6.6%), Math and Physical Sciences (6.3%), Business (15.8%), Engineering (12.1%), Architecture (7.9%) and USAS (5.2%). Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (49.2%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (50.5%), Engineering (64.3%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (44.9%), Pharmacy (70.7%) and Veterinary Medicine (45.3%) were international students. International graduate student enrollment at Columbus was 1,942 and the total university was 1,946. International graduate professional student enrollment was 4. [Table 10]
- Summer Quarter record high enrollments among African Americans (1,669) total and Hispanics (416 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased 3.2% (down 371 to 11,276) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents decreased 2.0% (down 28 to 1,382). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 107 to 4,631; -2.3%) and not-Ohio residents increased (up 96 to 3,221; 3.1%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased 5 to 1,029 (up 0.5%) and not-Ohio residents increased 30 to 61 (up 96.8%). [Table 14]
- Record high enrollment of 542 female Graduate Professional students was reached this Summer Quarter. [Tables 11 and Table 16]
