Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2006

August 11, 2006

Summer Quarter 2005 began June 19, 2006. A census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 7th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 305 compared to Summer Quarter of 2005 was recorded this quarter. An increase was experienced at Lima (up 5 to 438; 1.2%), Marion (up 36 to 453; 8.6%) and Wooster (up 24 to 174; 16.0%) yet Columbus (down 310 to 18,391; -1.7%), Mansfield (down 17 to 446; -3.7%), and Newark (down 43 to 582; -6.9%) had decreases in enrollment compared to Summer Quarter 2005. [Table 1].
- Undergraduate enrollment (down 50 to 11,919; -0.4%), graduate professional enrollment (down 32 to 1,002; -3.1%) and graduate enrollment (down 223 to 7,563; -2.9%) all decreased this quarter. New first quarter freshman (up 42 to 197; 27.1%), Transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 28 to 151; 22.8%), Transfer students above Rank 2 (up 28 to 704; 4.1%) and Former students (up 32 to 687; 4.9%) increased while Continuing students (down 180 to 10,180; -1.7%) decreased. New from OSU graduate student enrollment (up 2 to 678; 0.3%) was up while New to OSU graduate student enrollment (down 68 to 413; -14.1%), Continuing graduate student enrollment (down 85 to 5,820; -1.4%) and Former graduate student enrollment (down 72 to 652; -9.9%) was down. [Table 2].
- Five undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus recorded enrollment shifts of more than fifteen percent compared to last year. These are Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 14 to 7; -66.7%), Journalism (down 33 to 27; -55.0%), Architecture (up 20 to 74; 37.0%), Allied Medical Professions (up 55 to 310; 21.6%) and Social Work (down 14 to 45; -23.7%). Graduate programs with changes in excess of fifteen percent are: Human Ecology (down 13 to 51; -20.3%) and Social Work (up 53 to 248; 27.2%). The Graduate professional program in Law (down 31 to 113; -21.5%) and Pharmacy (down 4 to 11; -26.7%) recorded a change in excess of fifteen percent. [Table 3].
- Credits generated by full time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 3.8% (down 2,861 to 71,838) and the extended campuses increased 10.2% (up 796 to 8,635). The total decrease in full-time undergraduate credit hours was 2,065; down 2.5% from Summer Quarter 2005. Overall, part-time undergraduate credit hours increased (up 245 to 44,240; 0.6%). Overall, the total number of credit hours generated by undergraduates decreased 1,820 to 124,713 (down 1.4%) while the credits per student also decreased (down 0.11 to 10.46; -1.0%). With the decrease in the total number of graduate students, the total number of graduate credit hours decreased as well, (down 2,040 to 73,533; -2.7%). Full-time graduate credit hours decreased 2.4% to 52,167 on the Columbus campus yet increased 10.8% to 1,067 on the extended campuses as a whole yielding an overall full-time graduate credit hour decrease of 2.2% to 53,234. Graduate credits per student for the entire university were up 0.02 to 9.72 (0.2%). Graduate professional credit hours were down 1,380 to 14,933, (-8.5%) and credits per student were down 5.5% to 14.90. Undergraduate FTE decreased from 8,435 from Summer Quarter 2005 to 8,314. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 1,087 to 995. Graduate FTE decreased from 5,038 to 4,902. [Table 4]

- For the total university, twenty six counties recorded enrollment changes (positive or negative) in excess of twenty percent from last Summer; Adams (up 150.0%), Athens (up 41.9%), Auglaize (down 22.0%), Brown (up 28.6%), Columbiana (up 36.7%), Coshocton (up 23.3%), Crawford (down 21.1%), Darke (up 59.1%), Gallia (up 75.0%), Highland (up 21.1%), Hocking (down 31.3%), Holmes (up 31.3%), Jackson (up 33.3%), Lawrence (down 39.5%), Meigs (down 36.4%), Monroe (up 55.6%), Morgan (down 28.6%), Noble (up 80.0%), Paulding (down 21.7%), Pike (down 23.5%), Ross (down 22.1%), Scioto (down 33.3%), Shelby (up 30.0%), Union (up 25.0%), Vinton (down 28.6%) and Williams (down 31.0%). For the Columbus campus, twenty four counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent: Adams (up 100.0%), Athens (up 43.3%), Auglaize (down 28.8%), Brown (up 33.3%), Carroll (down 25.0%), Columbiana (up 31.3%), Coshocton (up 24.0%), Darke (up 59.1%), Gallia (up 90.0%), Hardin (up 36.4%), Hocking (down 37.5%), Holmes (up 85.7%), Jackson (up 36.4%), Lawrence (down 39.5%), Logan (up 26.1%), Meigs (down 45.5%), Monroe (up 85.7%), Noble (up 75.0%), Paulding (down 27.8%), Scioto (down 36.6%), Union (up 21.5%), Van Wert (down 25.0%), Vinton (down 28.6%) and Williams (down 32.1%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Texas (down 20.5%), Georgia (up 27.0%), Connecticut (down 22.7%), Oregon (down 23.5%), Oklahoma (up 38.9%), Arizona (down 40.0%), Washington (down 40.0%), Alaska (up 25.0%), New Hampshire (up 25.0%), District of Columbia (down 40.0%), Hawaii (down 33.3%), Mississippi (down 27.3%), Arkansas (down 58.8%), North Dakota (up 50.0%), Montana (down 50.0%), Nevada (up 100.0%), Wyoming (down 33.3%) and the Virgin Islands (up 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Texas (down 20.8%), Georgia (up 25.4%), Connecticut (down 22.7%), Oregon (down 23.5%), Oklahoma (up 38.9%), Arizona (down 40.0%), Washington (down 40.0%), New Hampshire (up 25.0%), District of Columbia (down 40.0%), Hawaii (down 33.3%), Mississippi (down 27.3%), Arkansas (down 64.7%), North Dakota (up 50.0%), Montana (down 50.0%), Nevada (up 100.0%), Wyoming (down 33.3%) and the Virgin Islands (up 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Taiwan (down 26.2%), Japan (Down 25.0%), Indonesia (down 28.6%), Saudi Arabia (up 1300%), Jamaica (up 325%), Romania (down 39.3%), Hong Kong (down 38.5%), and Columbia (down 21.4%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Summer Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India and Taiwan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 10.8 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Math and Physical Sciences (7.4%), Business (13.3%), Engineering (10.6%) and Architecture (6.8%). Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (49.5%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (47.0%), Engineering (60.3%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (46.9%), Pharmacy (75.4%) and Veterinary Medicine (41.2%) were international students. International graduate student enrollment at Columbus was 1,687. International graduate professional student enrollment was 10. [Table 10]
- Summer Quarter record high enrollments among Hispanic students (421 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents increased 0.1% (up 13 to 10,698) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents decreased 4.9% (down 63 to 1,221). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 58 to 4,569; 1.3%) while not-Ohio residents decreased (down 281 to 2,994; -8.6%). At the graduate professional level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 19 to 950; -2.0%) and not-Ohio residents also decreased (down 13 to 52; -20.0%). [Table 14]
