Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2007

August 9, 2007

Summer Quarter 2007 began June 18, 2007. A census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 6th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 4 compared to Summer Quarter of 2006 was recorded this quarter. An increase was experienced at Lima (up 7 to 445; 1.6%), Mansfield (up 17 to 463; 3.8%), Marion (up 21 to 474; 4.6%) and Newark (up 15 to 597; 2.6%) yet Columbus (down 41 to 18,350; -0.2%), and Wooster (down 23 to 151; -13.2%) experienced a decrease in enrollment compared to Summer Quarter 2006. [Table 1].
- For the entire university, undergraduate enrollment (down 11 to 11,908; -0.1%) and graduate professional enrollment (down 28 to 974; -2.8%) decreased while graduate enrollment increased (up 35 to 7,598; 0.5%) this quarter. Enrollment of undergraduate transfer students above Rank 2 (up 43 to 747; 6.1%), Continuing students (up 6 to 10,186; 0.1%) and Former students (up 15 to 702; 2.2%) increased while New First Quarter Freshman (down 60 to 137; -30.5%), and Transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 15 to 136; -9.9%) decreased. New to OSU graduate student enrollment (up 11 to 424; 2.7%), and Former graduate student enrollment (up 132 to 784; 20.2%) was up while New from OSU graduate student enrollment (down 61 to 617; -9.0%), and Continuing graduate student enrollment (down 47 to 5,773; -0.8%) was down. [Table 2].
- Six undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus recorded enrollment shifts of more than fifteen percent compared to last year. These are Arts and Sciences, Unknown (up 3 to 10; 42.9%), Architecture (down 12 to 62; -16.2%), Exploration (down 130 to 285; -31.3%), Nursing (up 48 to 177; 37.2%), Social Work (up 9 to 54; 20.0%), and Undergraduate Students Academic Services (up 47 to 57; 470.0%). Graduate programs with changes in excess of fifteen percent are: Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (up 71 to 314; 29.2%) and Social Work (down 52 to 196; -21.0%). The Graduate professional program in Law (down 31 to 82; -27.4%) and Pharmacy (down 5 to 6; -45.5%) recorded a change in excess of fifteen percent. [Table 3].
- Credits generated by full time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 0.4% (down 291 to 71,547) while the extended campuses increased 6.6% (up 566 to 9,201). The total increase in full time undergraduate credit hours was 275; up 0.3% from Summer Quarter 2006. Overall, part time undergraduate credit hours increased (up 99 to 44,339; 0.2%). Overall, the total number of credit hours generated by undergraduates increased 374 to 125,087 (up 0.3%) while the credits per student also increased (up 0.04 to 10.50; 0.4%). With the increase in the total number of graduate students, the total number of graduate credit hours increased as well (up 141 to 73,674; 0.2%). Full-time graduate credit hours decreased 0.4% to 51,975 on the Columbus campus and decreased 44.1% to 596 on the extended campuses as a whole, yielding an overall full-time graduate credit hour decrease of 1.2% to 52,571. Graduate credits per student for the entire university were down 0.03 to 9.70 (-0.3%). Graduate professional credit hours were down 385 to 14,548, (-2.6%) while credits per student were up 0.2% to 14.94. Undergraduate FTE increased from 8,314 to 8,339. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 995 to 970. Graduate FTE increased from 4,902 to 4,912. [Table 4]

- For the total university, twenty six counties recorded enrollment changes (positive or negative) in excess of twenty percent from last Summer: Adams (down 60.0%), Brown (up 44.4%), Carroll (down 53.8%), Henry (down 20.9%), Hocking (up 54.5%), Jackson (up 50.0%), Jefferson (down 30.0%), Lawrence (up 26.1%), Madison (up 24.7%), Meigs (up 28.6%), Monroe (down 50.0%), Morgan (down 40.0%), Morrow (up 29.3%), Muskingum (up 20.6%), Noble (down 44.4%), Portage (up 42.9%), Preble (up 46.7%), Ross (up 23.3%), Sandusky (up 29.7%), Scioto (up 64.3%), Seneca (up 32.0%), Tuscarawas (down 21.8%), Vinton (up 40.0%), Warren (up 33.3%), Washington (down 21.8%), and Wyandot (down 30.2%). For the Columbus campus, twenty four counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent: Adams (down 50.0%), Brown (up 62.5%), Carroll (down 44.4%), Henry (down 25.0%), Hocking (up 60.0%), Huron (up 20.9%), Jackson (up 60.0%), Jefferson (down 23.6%), Lawrence (up 26.1%), Madison (up 24.3%), Monroe (down 46.2%), Morgan (down 25.0%), Morrow (up 34.4%), Muskingum (up 23.5%), Noble (down 42.9%), Portage (up 42.4%), Preble (up 46.2%), Ross (up 23.3%), Scioto (up 76.9%), Seneca (up 36.6%), Vinton (up 40.0%), Warren (up 36.3%), Washington (down 22.2%), and Wyandot (down 34.8%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Arizona (up 91.7%), South Carolina (up 44.4%), Washington (up 25.0%), Puerto Rico (up 38.9%), Alabama (up 21.1%), Nebraska (up 27.8%), New Mexico (up 28.6%), New Hampshire (up 70.0%), Kansas (down 23.8%), Idaho (down 40.0%), Arkansas (up 100%), District of Columbia (up 55.6%), Nevada (up 225.0%), Mississippi (up 50.0%), North Dakota (up 50.0%), Delaware (down 22.2%), Hawaii (down 25.0%), Vermont (down 33.3%), Wyoming (up 50.0%), South Dakota (up 25.0%) and Montana (down 50.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Arizona (up 91.7%), South Carolina (up 44.4%), Washington (up 25.0%), Puerto Rico (up 33.3%), Alabama (up 21.1%), Nebraska (up 27.8%), New Mexico (up 28.6%), New Hampshire (up 70.0%), Idaho (down 40.0%), Kansas (down 28.6%), District of Columbia (up 55.6%), Arkansas (up 116.7%), Nevada (up 225.0%), Mississippi (up 50.0%), North Dakota (up 50.0%), Delaware (down 22.2%), Hawaii (down 25.0%), Vermont (down 33.3%), Wyoming (up 50.0%), South Dakota (up 25.0%) and Montana (down 50.0%) [Table 7 and Table 8]
- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Indonesia (down 41.5%), Saudi Arabia (down 40.5%), Mexico (down 28.6%), Italy (up 50.0%), Peru (up 71.4%) and Hong Kong (down 37.5%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Summer Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India and Taiwan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 9.2 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Mathematical and Physical Sciences (7.1%), Business (11.8%), Engineering (8.7%) and Architecture (6.5%). Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (47.9%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (45.0%), Engineering (58.5%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (44.3%), and Pharmacy (66.7%) were international students. International graduate student enrollment at Columbus was 1,668 for Summer Quarter 2007, and international graduate professional student enrollment was 9. [Table 10]
- Summer Quarter record high enrollments among Hispanic students (455 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased 0.3% (down 29 to 10,669) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased 1.5% (up 18 to 1,239). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 55 to 4,624; 1.2%) while not-Ohio residents decreased (down 20 to 2,974; -0.7%). At the graduate professional level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 15 to 935; -1.6%) and not-Ohio residents also decreased (down 13 to 39; -25.0%). [Table 14]
