Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Summer Quarter of 2008

August 15, 2008

Summer Quarter 2008 began June 16, 2008. A census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on August 4th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 598 compared to Summer Quarter of 2007 was recorded this quarter. An increase was experienced at Columbus (up 741 to 19,091; 4.0%) and Wooster (up 16 to 167; 10.6%) yet Lima (down 56 to 389; -12.6%), Mansfield (down 77 to 386; -16.6%), and Newark (down 26 to 571; -4.4%) all experienced decreases in enrollment compared to Summer Quarter 2007. Marion's enrollment remained the same at 474. [Table 1].
- For the entire university, undergraduate enrollment (up 377 to 12,285; 3.2%), graduate professional enrollment (up 123 to 1,097; 12.6%), and graduate enrollment (up 98 to 7,696; 1.3%) increased this quarter. Enrollment of New First Quarter Freshman (up 70 to 207; 51.1%), undergraduate transfer students above Rank 2 (up 29 to 776; 3.9%), and Continuing students (up 324 to 10,510; 3.2%) increased while Transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 30 to 106; -22.1%) and Former students (down 16 to 686; -2.3%) decreased. New to OSU graduate student enrollment (up 100 to 524; 23.6%), Continuing graduate student enrollment (up 30 to 5,803; 0.5%) and Former graduate student enrollment (up 27 to 811; 3.4%) was up while New from OSU graduate student enrollment (down 59 to 558; -9.6%), was down. [Table 2].
- Five undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus recorded enrollment shifts of more than fifteen percent compared to last year. These are Arts and Sciences (up 2 to 12; 20.0%), Earth Sciences (up 7 to 27; 35.0%), Business (up 224 to 1,295; 20.9%), Social Work (up 22 to 76; 40.7%), and Undergraduate Students Academic Services (up 52 to 109; 91.2%). Graduate programs with changes in excess of fifteen percent are: Earth Sciences (down 8 to 35; -18.6%), Architecture (down 16 to 54; -22.9%), Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 254 to 971; 35.4%), Public Affairs (up 12 to 48; 33.3%) and Social Work (up 49 to 245; 25.0%). The Graduate professional program in Dentistry (up 112 to 326; 52.3%) and Pharmacy (down 2 to 4; -33.3%) recorded a change in excess of fifteen percent. [Table 3].
- Credits generated by full time undergraduates at Columbus increased 2.7% (up 1,919 to 73,466) while the extended campuses decreased (down 1,515 to 7,686; -16.5%). The total increase in full time undergraduate credit hours was 404; up 0.5% from Summer Quarter 2007. Overall, part time undergraduate credit hours increased (up 2,163 to 46,502; 4.9%). The total number of credit hours generated by undergraduates increased 2,567 to 127,654 (up 2.1%) but the credits per student decreased (down 0.11 to 10.39; -1.1%). The total number of graduate credit hours decreased (down 754 to 72,920; -1.0%). Full-time graduate credit hours decreased 3.0% to 50,392 on the Columbus campus and decreased 27.0% to 435 on the extended campuses as a whole, yielding an overall full-time graduate credit hour decrease of 3.3% to 50,827. Graduate credits per student for the entire university were down 0.22 to 9.48 (-2.3%). Graduate professional credit hours were up 1,707 to 16,255, (11.7%) but credits per student were down 0.8% to 14.82. Undergraduate FTE increased from 8,339 to 8,510. Graduate professional FTE increased from 970 to 1,084. Graduate FTE decreased from 4,912 to 4,861. [Table 4]

- For the total university, twenty two counties recorded enrollment changes (positive or negative) in excess of twenty percent from last Summer: Adams (up 150.0%), Ashtabula (down 23.9%), Athens (down 25.0%), Carroll (up 50.0%), Darke (up 37.9%), Fulton (up 37.5%), Geauga (up 30.6%), Hancock (up 20.9%), Henry (down 44.1%), Highland (up 23.1%), Jackson (down 62.5%), Jefferson (up 42.9%), Meigs (down 77.8%), Miami (up 22.0%), Morgan (up 133.3%), Morrow (down 28.9%), Pike (up 33.3%), Preble (down 50.0%), Seneca (down 25.8%), Washington (up 65.1%), Williams (up 68.4%) and Wyandot (up 56.7%). For the Columbus campus, twenty six counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent: Adams (up 100.0%), Ashtabula (down 25.0%), Athens (down 21.1%), Auglaize (Up 22.4%), Champaign (up 25.0%), Darke (up 32.1%), Fulton (up 35.5%), Geauga (up 33.9%), Hancock (up 34.0%), Harrison (down 28.6%), Henry (down 40.7%), Highland (up 30.4%), Holmes (up 23.1%), Jackson (down 62.5%), Jefferson (up 38.1%), Meigs (down 71.4%), Miami (up 24.4%), Monroe (down 28.6%), Morgan (up 100.0%), Morrow (down 23.3%), Noble (up 50.0%), Preble (down 52.6%), Seneca (down 25.0%), Washington (up 61.9%), Williams (up 61.1%) and Wyandot (up 66.7%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Minnesota (up 21.6%), Washington (up 60.0%), Arizona (down 21.7%), Colorado (down 23.8%), Louisiana (down 28.0%), Nevada (up 30.8%), Oregon (down 51.6%), New Mexico (down 33.3%), Wyoming (up 66.7%), Alaska (down 30.8%), Delaware (up 28.6%), Vermont (up 50.0%), South Dakota (up 60.0%), Arkansas (down 50.0%), North Dakota (down 44.4%), Rhode Island (down 54.5%), Montana (up 50.0%) and the Virgin Islands (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Summer were: Minnesota (up 21.6%), Washington (up 60.0%), Arizona (down 21.7%), Colorado (down 23.8%), Puerto Rico (up 20.8%), Louisiana (down 28.0%), Nevada (up 30.8%), Oregon (down 51.6%), New Mexico (down 33.3%), Wyoming (up 66.7%), Delaware (up 28.6%), Vermont (up 50.0%), Alaska (down 33.3%), South Dakota (up 60.0%), Arkansas (down 46.2%), Maine (down 22.2%), North Dakota (down 44.4%), Rhode Island (down 54.5%), Montana (up 50.0%) and the Virgin Islands (down 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Canada (up 23.9%), Japan (down 22.7%), Libya (up 3,200.0%), Malaysia (down 22.6%), Mexico (up 26.7%), United Arab Emirates (up 90.0%), Brazil (up 28.6%), Hong Kong (up 70.0%), Italy (up 25.0%), France (up 30.0%), Argentina (down 25.0%) and Kenya (up 50.0%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Summer Quarter. People's Republic of China, India, Republic of Korea, and Taiwan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. For the entire university, total enrollment of international students increased 7.4% this quarter. [Table 9]
- This quarter, Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 12.2 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Mathematical and Physical Sciences (8.3%), Business (14.8%), Continuing Education (12.2%), Engineering (10.2%) and Pharmacy (6.0%). Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (46.4%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (45.2%), Engineering (59.6%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (48.4%), and Pharmacy (64.7%) were international students. International graduate student enrollment at Columbus was 1,707 for Summer Quarter 2008, and international graduate professional student enrollment was 7. [Table 10]
- Summer Quarter record high enrollments among Hispanic students (473 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 11, 12, and 13]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents increased 2.9% (up 309 to 10,978) as did enrollment of not-Ohio residents (up 68 to 1,307; 5.5%). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents (up 70 to 4,694; 1.5%) and not-Ohio residents (up 28 to 3,002; 0.9%) increased. At the graduate professional level, enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 124 to 1,059; 13.3%) while the not-Ohio residents enrollment decreased (down 1 to 38; -2.6%). [Table 14]
