Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Winter Quarter of 2001

January 26, 2001

Winter Quarter 2001 began on January 2, 2001. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on January 16th. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall decrease in enrollment of 289 students compared to Winter Quarter 2000 was recorded for this quarter for a total of 52,595. All but one campus experienced decreases in enrollment; Columbus (down 315 to 46,044; -0.7%), Lima (down 77 to 1,184; -6.1%), Mansfield (down 58 to 1,415; -3.9%), Marion (down 2 to 1,179; -0.2%) and Wooster (down 18 to 893; -2.0%). Only Newark had an increase, up 181 to 1,880; 10.7%. [Table 1]

- The decrease in undergraduate enrollment (down 363 to 40,290; -0.9%) was the primary reason for the decrease in total enrollment. Graduate enrollment decreased (down 14 to 9,487; -0.1%) while graduate professional enrollment increased (up 88 to 2,818; 3.2%). Overall, all sources of undergraduate enrollment decreased; new first-quarter freshmen down 61 to 493; (-11.0%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 down 68 to 513; (-11.7%), transfer students above Rank 2 decreased 4.4% (down 27 to 583), continuing students (down 163 to 37,328; -0.4%) and returning students decreased 44 to 1,373; (-3.1%). At the extended campuses as a whole, three undergraduate source categories recorded an increase. Enrollment of new first quarter freshmen (up 39 to 191, 25.7%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 4 to 71; 6.0%) and continuing students (up 75 to 5,343; 1.4%). The remaining two categories experienced decreases; transfer students above Rank 2 was down 13 to 176 (-6.9%) and enrollment of returning students was down 4 to 298 (-1.3%). All of the sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus decreased: new first-quarter freshmen (down 100 to 302, -24.9%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 72 to 442, -14.0%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 14 to 407; -3.3%), continuing students (down 238 to 31,985, -0.7%) and returning students (down 40 to 1,075; -3.6%). The enrollment of graduate students at the Columbus campus for Winter 2001 was higher than Winter 2000, with an increase of 61 to 9,015 (0.7%). The enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was down 75 to 472 (-13.7%). Overall enrollment of new graduate students was up 30 to 443 (7.3%). Enrollment of both continuing graduate students (down 12 to 8,434; -0.1%) and returning graduate students (down 32 to 610; - 5.0%) was down. As a result, enrollment of graduate students was down 14 to 9,487 (-0.1%) overall. Enrollment of graduate professional students was up 88 to 2,818 (3.2%). [Table 2].

- Five undergraduate curricular academic programs at Columbus saw a decrease in enrollment from Winter 2000 in excess of ten percent. They were Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 171 to 116; -59.6%), Education (down 63 to 384; -14.1%), Natural Resources (down 80 to 238; -25.2%), Pharmacy (down 55 to 216; -20.3%) and UVC (down 1,802 to 10,042; -15.2%). Enrollment in four curricular academic programs saw an increase in enrollment from Winter 2000 in excess of ten percent: The Arts (up 538 to 1,487; 56.7%), Biological Sciences (up 210 to 1,541; 15.8%), Math and Physical Sciences (up 66 to 641; 11.5%) and Architecture (up 143 to 462; 44.8%). Graduate level programs recording changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent with the indicated number and percent change were: Business (up 85 to 650; 15.0%), Education (down 286 to 2089, -12.0%), Architecture (up 17 to 172, 11.0%), Allied Medical Professions (down 25 to 43, -36.8%), Other Graduate Interdisciplinary (up 370 to 503, 278.2%) and the graduate program in Veterinary Medicine (down 24 to 74; -24.5%). The graduate professional program in Pharmacy recorded an increase of 45,1%, an increase of 65 to 209. [Table 3 and Table 4]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduates decreased at Columbus (down 2,785 to 460,223; -0.6%) and increased for the extended campuses as a whole (up 1,966 to 66,942; 3.0%). The net result was a total decrease of 819 to 527,165 (-0.2%) from Winter Quarter 2000. Credits for part-time students decreased in total; down 1,238 to 48,116 (-2.5%). Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 2.2% (down 822 to 36,111) while the extended campuses decreased 3.3% (down 416 to 12,005). The total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university decreased 2,057 to 575,281 (-0.4%). Although credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level for the university decreased, credit per student increased slightly (up 0.08 to 14.28, 0.5%) compared to Winter 2000. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 1,565 to 101,301; 1.6%). The Columbus campus increased 1,378 to 96,768; (1.4%) and the extended campuses as a whole increased 187 to 4,533; (4.3%). Graduate credits per student for the university as a whole were up 1.7 percent with 10.68 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were down by 1.1 percent even though total credits increased 1,107 credits to 53,970. Undergraduate FTE decreased from 38,489 to 38,352. Graduate professional FTE increased from 3,524 to 3,598. Graduate FTE increased from 6,649 to 6,753. [Table 5]
- For the total university, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last winter; Meigs (down 22.2%), Noble (down 26.1%), Preble (up 21.3) and Vinton (up 50.0%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Crawford (down 24.2%), Meigs (down 22.2%), Noble (down 26.1%) Preble (up 28.6%) and Van Wert (up 25.4%). U.S. Territories decreased 21.4%. [Table 6 and Table 7]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: Puerto Rico (down 25.0%), Arizona (down 25.0%), Arkansas (up 23.8%), Hawaii (up 38.9%), District of Columbia (up 23.5%), Idaho (up 41.7%) and Wyoming (down 60.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: Puerto Rico (down 25.0%), Arizona (down 25.0%), Arkansas (up 23.8%), Hawaii (up 38.9%), District of Columbia (up 23.5%), Idaho (up 41.7) and Wyoming (down 60.0%) [Table 8 and Table 9]

- Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, India (up 29.9%), Turkey (up 32.7%), Canada (up 20.3%), Malaysia (down 21.4%), Saudi Arabia (up 21.4%), Pakistan (up 31.8%), England (down 28.9%), Mexico (down 22.6%), Spain (up 35.3%) and Egypt (up 42.9%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Winter Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Indonesia, Taiwan, Japan and Turkey recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 10]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 14.3 percent. Undergraduate curricular academic programs with international student enrollment in excess of five percent were Business (9.6%), Engineering (7.5%), and Architecture (5.6%). International student enrollment was 3,911 for the total university and 3,900 on the Columbus campus. Forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (42.3%), Journalism (50.0%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (50.3%), Engineering (69.5%), Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (44.4%), and Pharmacy (40.9%) were international students. Total University enrollment of 26 International Graduate Professional and 2,460 Graduate students were record highs for Winter Quarter. [Table 11]
- Winter Quarter record high enrollments among American Indians or Alaskan Natives (172 at Columbus, 201 total) and Hispanics (859 at Columbus, 915 total) were reached this quarter. [Tables 12, 13, and 14]
- At the undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 502 to 36,085; -1.4%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased (up 139 to 4,205; 3.4%). Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 126 to 5,600; -2.2%) and not-Ohio residents increased (up 112 to 3,887; 3.0%). Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased 71 to 2,613 (up 2.8%) and not-Ohio residents increased 17 to 205 (up 9.0%). [Table 15]
- Record high enrollment of 1,402 female Graduate Professional students was reached this Winter Quarter. [Table 16]
