Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Winter Quarter of 2008

January 25, 2008

Winter Quarter 2008 began on January 3, 2008. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on January 23rd. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 1,089 students compared to Winter Quarter 2007 was reported this quarter for a total of 58,524. Five campuses experienced increases in enrollment: Columbus (up 763 to 51,129; 1.5%), Lima (up 107 to 1,294; 9.0%), Mansfield (up 68 to 1,533; 4.6%), Marion (up 6 to 1,512; 0.4%), and Newark (up 167 to 2,376; 7.6%), while the remaining campus experienced a decrease: Wooster (down 22 to 680; -3.1%). [Table 1]

- Undergraduate and Graduate student enrollments experienced increases compared to Winter Quarter 2007. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 990 to 45,135 (2.2%) and Graduate enrollment increased by 122 to 10,159 (1.2%) while Graduate Professional enrollment decreased by 23 to 3,230 (-0.7%). Three sources of total undergraduate enrollment experienced decreases: new first-quarter freshmen (down 59 to 224; -20.8%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 71 to 544; -11.5%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 103 to 578; -15.1%). The remaining two source categories experienced an increase: continuing students (up 1,178 to 42,563; 2.8%) and returning students (up 45 to 1,226; 3.8%). Three sources of undergraduate enrollment at the extended campuses increased: transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 18 to 110; 19.6%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 2 to 144; 1.4%), and continuing students (up 420 to 6,345; 7.1%). The remaining source categories at the extended campuses experienced decreases in enrollment: new first quarter freshmen (down 26 to 166, -13.5%) and returning students (down 38 to 325; -10.5%). At the Columbus campus, two of the undergraduate source categories recorded increases: continuing students (up 758 to 36,218; 2.1%) and returning students (up 83 to 901; 10.1%). The undergraduate source categories that experienced decreases were new first quarter freshmen (down 33 to 58; -36.3%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 89 to 434; -17.0%), and transfer students above Rank 2 (down 105 to 434; -19.5%). Graduate student enrollment at the Columbus campus for Winter 2008 was greater than Winter 2007, an increase of 172 to 9,854 (1.8%) was reported. Enrollment of graduate students at all extended campuses was down 50 to 305 (-14.1%). Overall, enrollment of new graduate students was up 59 to 411 (16.8%). Enrollment of continuing graduate students increased (up 73 to 9,232; 0.8%) while returning students decreased (down 10 to 516; -1.9%). As a result, enrollment of graduate students as a whole was up 122 to 10,159 (1.2%). Enrollment of graduate professional students was down 23 to 3,230 (-0.7%). [Table 2].

- Two undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus saw an increase in enrollment from Winter 2007 in excess of ten percent: Mathematical and Physical Sciences (up 117 to 1,167; 11.1%) and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (up 71 to 294; 31.8%). No undergraduate curricular academic programs at the Columbus campus decreased in excess of ten percent in enrollment from Winter 2007. Graduate level programs reporting changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent were: Biological Sciences (down 61 to 370; -14.2%), Architecture (up 20 to 203; 10.9%), Environment and Natural Resources (down 9 to 65; -12.2%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (up 73 to 389; 23.1%), and Nursing (up 29 to 315; 10.1%). [Table 3]
- Credits generated by full-time undergraduates increased at the Columbus campus (up 9,756 to 554,756; 1.8%) and at the extended campuses (up 4,604 to 86,667; 5.6%). The result was an overall increase of 14,360 to 641,423 (2.3%) from Winter Quarter 2007. Credits for part-time students increased in total (up 1,449 to 37,783; 4.0%). Credits at the extended campuses generated by part-time students increased (up 368 to 10,661; 3.6%) as well as at the Columbus campus (up 1,081 to 27,122; 4.2%). Total credits generated by undergraduates for the entire university increased 15,809 to 679,206 (2.4%). While the total credit hours at the undergraduate level for the university increased, credits per student increased (up 0.02 to 15.05, 0.1%) compared to Winter 2007. At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 1,183 to 118,672; 1.0%); at the Columbus campus an increase in credits was reported (up 1,935 to 116,191; 1.7%) while the extended campuses as a whole reported a decrease (down 752 to 2,481; -23.3%). Graduate credits per student for the entire university were down 0.2% with 11.68 credits per student. Graduate professional credits per student were up 0.3% but total credits decreased (down 251 to 58,091; -0.4%). Undergraduate full time equivalents (FTE) increased from 44,226 to 45,280. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 3,889 to 3,872. Graduate FTE increased from 7,833 to 7,911. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following counties reported enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from last winter: Brown (up 44.7%), Clinton (up 29.2%), Meigs (down 28.1%), and Monroe (down 20.7%). For the Columbus campus, the counties which recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent were Brown (up 48.5%), Clinton (up 21.1%), Meigs (down 23.1%), and Monroe (down 25.0%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: Florida (up 24.9%), Minnesota (up 20.4%), Washington (up 24.6%), New Hampshire (up 28.6%), New Mexico (up 24.0%), Maine (up 23.8%), Hawaii (up 37.5%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 29.4%), North Dakota (down 22.2%), Virgin Islands (down 66.7%), Military Address (down 100.0%), and Palau Island (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent from last Winter were: Florida (up 25.4%), Minnesota (up 20.4%), Washington (up 23.1%), New Hampshire (up 28.6%), New Mexico (up 25.0%), Hawaii (up 37.5%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 29.4%), North Dakota (down 22.2%), Virgin Islands (down 66.7%), Military Address (down 100.0%), and Palau Island (down 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at Ohio State, Indonesia (down 28.2%), Pakistan (up 40.0%), Saudi Arabia (down 37.5%), France (up 26.3%), Italy (up 37.5%), United Arab Emirates (up 122.2%), and Greece (up 36.4%), reported changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from last Winter Quarter. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, Canada, and Japan recorded enrollment of 100 or more students this quarter. [Table 9]
- Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 11.4%; this is up from 10.7% last Winter. International student enrollment was recorded at 3,497 for the total university and 3,488 on the Columbus campus. There are several graduate programs in which forty percent or more of students enrolled were international students; these programs included: Biological Sciences (46.5%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (46.7%), Engineering (57.6%), Food, Agriculture, and Environmental Sciences (42.9%) and Pharmacy (55.8%). - At the undergraduate level, both enrollment of Ohio residents (up 782 to 40,662; 2.0%) and non-Ohio residents (up 208 to 4,473; 4.9%) increased. Similarly, graduate enrollment of Ohio residents (up 41 to 5,899; 0.7%) and non-Ohio residents (up 81 to 4,260; 1.9%) increased. Graduate professional enrollment of Ohio residents increased (up 19 to 2,921, 0.7%) while non-Ohio residents (down 42 to 309; -12.0%) decreased this quarter. [Table 14]
- Winter Quarter 2008 reported record high enrollments for total students of 58,524, total undergraduate students (45,135), total undergraduate female students (21,529), total female students (28,928), and Hispanic students (1,409).
